### **AEGEAN grows its fleet by placing a firm order for 8 additional Airbus A321 neo aircraft**

**With the additional order, the total number of A320 - A321neo in AEGEAN fleet will reach 58 aircraft**

Athens, March 14<sup>th</sup>, 2025

AEGEAN announces the order of 8 additional A321neo aircraft, thus further expanding for the third time its original agreement with Airbus for A320 / A321neo family aircraft, initially signed in 2018, with the first deliveries starting in 2020.

It is worth noting that out of the 58 Airbus A320 / A321neo aircraft, 37 will be the larger version of the A321neo family. Among them, four (4) will be Airbus A321neo LR (Long Range), offering significantly extended range and a newly designed passenger cabin, specifically configured to serve flights to new markets of up to 7.5 hours.

To date, 34 Airbus A320 / A321neo family aircraft have already been delivered while 24 more aircraft are scheduled to be delivered in the coming years, including the new order. In 2025, AEGEAN has already taken delivery of one (1) A320neo aircraft and is planning to take delivery of four (4) more new aircraft of the A320 / A321 neo family.

**Dimitris Gerogiannis, AEGEAN's CEO, commented:** "The expansion of our investment plan with the additional order of 8 new Airbus A321neo aircraft is essential for achieving our growth objectives and further enhancing the competitiveness of our operations. It is also clear that we have a strong preference for the larger-capacity and extended-range version of the A321neo type, which will soon represent two-thirds of our Airbus fleet. We thank Airbus for their outstanding partnership, and we once again promise our passengers that we will make the best possible use of our new aircraft, bringing all the creativity and dedication of our team to deliver new services, new destinations, and even better travel experiences."

AEGEAN, along with its subsidiary Olympic Air carried 16.3 million passengers in 2024, offering 19.7 million seats across 47 countries. In 2025 AEGEAN's network includes 250 routes, both scheduled and charter flights (55 domestic and 195 international routes), connecting 162 destinations in Europe, Middle East, and North Africa. These routes are operated from AEGEAN's seven bases in Greece and abroad, with a fleet of 83 aircraft, including the latest Airbus A320 and A321 neo family aircraft.
